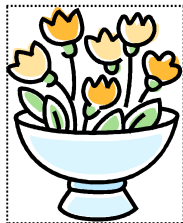

From the desk of the Principal

Dear Parents

We certainly have experienced diverse weather conditions over the past week ranging from hot and humid, to gale force winds to most welcome soaking rain. Parents are often concerned about the impact that this has on the outdoor activities, resulting in a number of calls being directed to the office. Please reacquaint yourselves with the following scenarios.

RESPONSES TO FAQ:

Q: What happens when sport is cancelled?

A: It is our policy not to cancel sport unless deemed imperative to do so. In the event of inclement weather conditions you *do not* need to *phone* the office to check whether sport has been cancelled. Your daughter will be looked after by the teacher-in-charge of the sport. She will be taken to the teacher's classroom and dismissed at the normal time when that sport would normally end. She will not be expected to wait outside

for you in the heat, the wind or the rain. You may fetch her at the usual time from the Rochelle Road waiting area or your usual collection point.

Q: What do I do when my daughter is ill?

A: It is not necessary to phone in if your daughter is ill, unless she will be off for a few days. On her return to school, you would need to submit a letter to her class teacher explaining her absence from school.

Q: How can my daughter catch up work missed as a result of illness? (Grade 4-7)

A: Ideally we would want your daughter to recover completely before returning to school. Should you want to collect homework for her please phone through to the office by 10:00, a message will be relayed to her class teacher and the homework can be collected from the front office after 14:30.

Q: What do I do if my daughter leaves her belongings at home?

A: It is your daughter's responsibility to bring what

she needs for school. Encourage her to develop a routine during which time she can check that she has everything she requires before leaving home in the morning. The aim is for her to become less dependent on you. This is an invaluable life skill that she can learn at an early age. You are discouraged from bringing these items to school during the school day.

As the weather forecast for Friday was going to jeopardise the gala, at our pool, the decision was made to move to the Newton Park Pool. This was a first for us and an interesting experience for both the staff and the girls. They were all flexible and adapted well to the new venue and a pleasant day was had by all with Queen Victoria winning the day. I was unfortunately unable to attend due to circumstances beyond my control!
