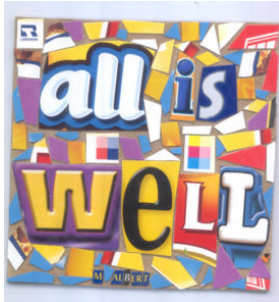


Cereal box art

I would like you to think of a quote, a sentence or thought about how you feel at this time being in lockdown. You then need to search for letters and pictures to create a collage showcasing your quote.

You will need to stick your letters and pictures down on a backing - a cereal box works well! If you don't have any glue try mixing a thin paste of flour, a little salt and water...you'd be amazed at how it will actually stick paper together! Just give it time to dry.

Try your best to cover the entire backing without leaving gaps - just like in the images on this page. You have two weeks to complete this project, but if this is not enough time let me know.
