

INTERJECTIONS

An interjection is a word of exclamation that is used to express (show) surprise, disgust, joy and excitement.

If the interjection is strong, then it will stand alone and be followed by an exclamation mark. E.g. **Gosh!** That was scary.

If the interjection is not very strong, then it will be followed by a comma. E.g. **Yum,** that piece of cake was nice.
