

Simple continuous tense

Future and present continuous tense shows that the action will be ongoing,
e.g. Future continuous - *I shall be taking you to school next week.*

Present continuous - *I am singing a song.*

The verb changes and usually gets “-ing” on the end.

<u>Present tense</u>	<u>Present continuous tense</u>
She stays in Quarry Bay.	She is staying in Quarry Bay.
My head aches.	My head is aching.
