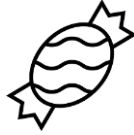


# Example Word Sums

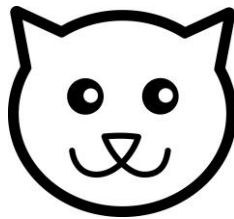
Mom gives you 6 sweets and dad gives 5 sweets, how many sweets do you have altogether?



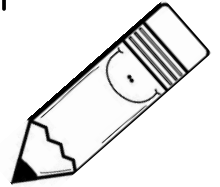
There are 3 tricycles, how many wheels are there altogether?



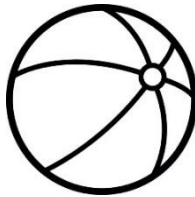
There are 4 cats, how many ears do they have altogether?



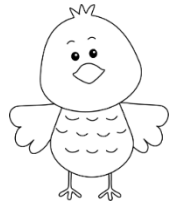
Alison bought a pencil for R3 and a notebook for R6, how much money fingers did she spend altogether?



I buy a bouncy ball for R5 and stickers for R2, how much did I spend altogether?



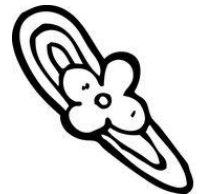
There are 8 chicks in a nest, 4 fly away. How many chicks are left in the nest?



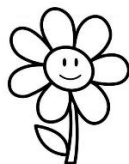
There are 10 cupcakes, Sally ate 3 cupcakes. How many cupcakes are left?
