It has been brought to my attention that the girls (and parents) have been a bit overwhelmed by the amount of Maths work given. I do apologise for this and have tried to rectify the problem this week.

Please read the instructions carefully as I have included OPTIONAL work which does NOT need to be done. This work is simply for those who feel that they need or want more practice for a certain concept.

Once again, I apologise for any errors on memos. I have tried to check these carefully.

I had prepared an Informal Fractions Test but have decided to complete this at a later date, or even when the girls are back. All the work completed so far, will be revised. I will be giving baseline assessments once we return to school, and before any new concepts are taught, so that I can gauge how well the girls have grasped concepts covered during lockdown.

Just to explain why I have used the Worksheet Cloud platform. I really like the way in which Mr T explains the concepts and feel that the girls are able to stop the video whenever necessary or go back to check a concept again. It also means that the concepts have been covered and I will be able to REVISE concepts rather than start from scratch when we return. The Department has removed very little from the Maths syllabus, so we are under pressure to finish all the concepts. Using these videos helps us to overcome this problem.
