What did the person have to say to the 42 gods?

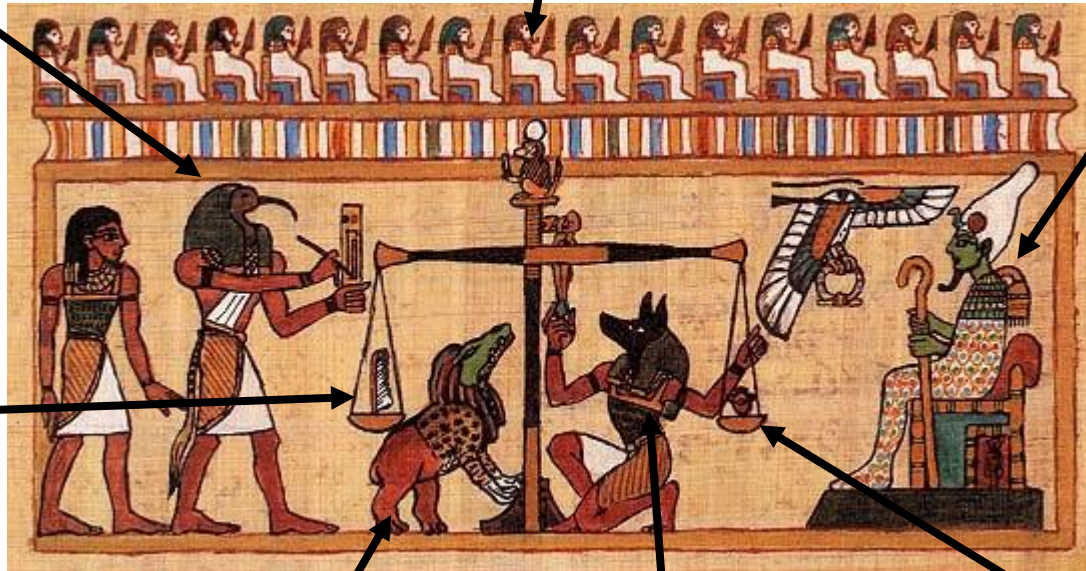
The dead person had to convince the 42 gods that he had lived a good life.
